A motion was made by Erickson, and was seconded by Gottula to approve the minutes from July 9, 2019. Yeas: Gottula, Erickson, Evans, Nays; none motion carried.

Steve Mercure was present at the meeting to discuss with the board the protest he filed. Steve offered a copy of the appraisal of Real Property dated January 1, 2018, he also presented to the board a copy of the Decision and Order Reversing County Board of Equalization on Case No 18R-0069 from the Nebraska Tax Equalization and Review Commission dated June 7, 2019 and gave his testimony.

The board reviewed all of the protest that were filed.
